

Bridgeport Hotel access guide



Entrances

You can enter the Bridgeport through the Lounge, or through the Reception.

Carparking is in front of the reception.

The entrances are level, and there is an elevator inside.



Ordering

You can order through the QR codes on tables, or at the main bar in the Rivergum restaurant.



Reception

There will be someone at the reception desk. If you are staying in the hotel accommodation, this is where you will check in.

Sounds from the kitchen may be noticeable here.

The Lounge

There are automatic doors at the entrance.

The lounge has many couches, and softer, lower chairs compared to the restaurant.

There is a neon pink sign which says 'wish you were here.'

There are several TVs on the wall.

If you walk past the gaming room you may hear the machines, but the sound is at a low level.







Rivergum Restaurant

There is:

- Natural light from windows
- Yellow hanging lights
- Fluorescent lights on the ceiling and wall
- Blue strip lighting on the bar

The seating area is carpeted.

There is chairs with padding and booth seating available.

The kitchen is visible and noises are noticeable.

There is music played at a moderate level.

If you sit near the bar, you may hear sounds like the coffee machine buzzing, cutlery being put on the bar, and other noises.





Main toilets

There are bright fluorescent lights on the ceiling.

Both paper towel and hand dryers are available.

There is a separate disabled toilet.





Terrace

There is a large TV playing sport. There may or may not be sound playing.

There is music playing at a low level, quieter than inside.

There are bulb string lights, but they are not on during the day.

You can hear cars driving past and birds chirping.

There are lattice chairs and flat chairs.

There are three different heights of tables to choose from.





Quiet Dinner

The Quiet Dinner will be held in the Charles Sturt Room.

This is a private room.

There will be dimmed lighting and no background music.

You have to walk through the restaurant to get to the Charles Sturt Room.

There will be a breakout space available. Signs will let you know where it is.

There are male, female and disabled toilets inside the Charles Sturt room.
